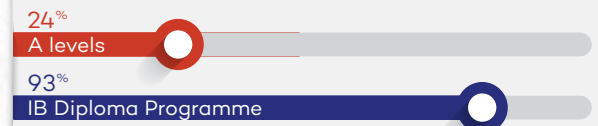

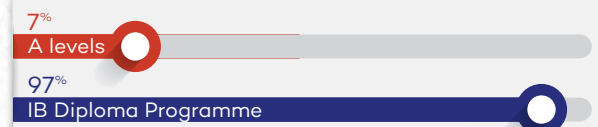

IBDP English provides the equivalency to English proficiency tests such as IELTS/TOEFL etc if students receive 4 or more in the subject.



What does IBDP look like at Sampoerna Academy Jakarta?

- ✓ Wide range of subjects offered in all the groups
- ✓ All teachers are IB trained and will be sent for required training as per requirement
- ✓ We have 33 IB classes to choose from including Standard Level and Higher Level
- ✓ IB ensures smaller class sizes for IB specific courses
- ✓ The extended essay that students participate in gives them exposure and direction for future college papers and research projects
- ✓ The CAS (creativity, activity and service) process teaches the students how to think introspectively, evaluating and reflecting on each activity they complete
- ✓ The Theory of Knowledge class teaches students how to realize and acknowledge the role bias plays in data and forming their knowledge base. This encourages students to question the norms of self and society

Subject offered are:

- A HL (Higher Level) subject represents a minimum of 240 hours of classroom study, while an SL (Standard Level) subject represents a minimum of 150 hours.
- Students need to choose 3 HL and 3 SL subjects. TOK (Theory of Knowledge), CAS (Creativity, Activity & Services) and EE (Extended Essay) are compulsory to achieve the diploma. Student is allowed select 4 HL subject and 2 SL subjects, only with DP coordinators approval.

At Sampoerna Academy, we also offer an IB Course Certificate Program for those students who want to enroll for IB courses and not pursue the full Diploma program. Under IBO rules, a candidate will be awarded a certificate for every IB subject in which they complete all subject requirements.

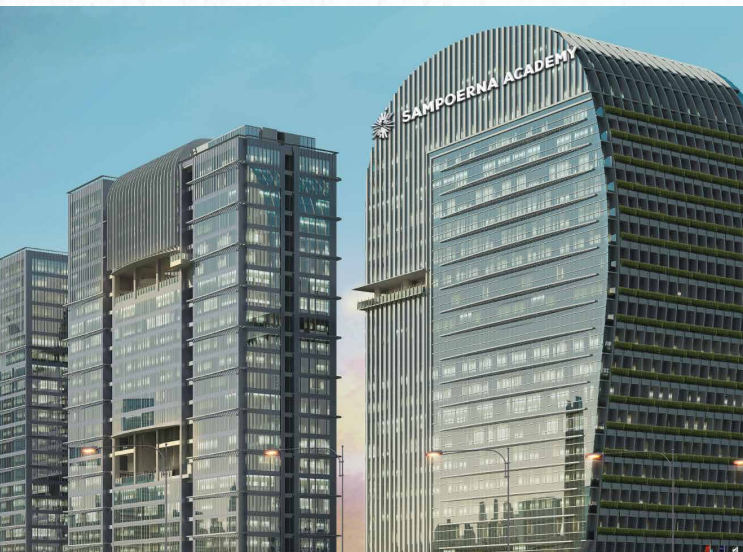
What Will an IB Program Do for You?

The International Baccalaureate® (IB), and the Diploma Program (DP) in particular, enjoys a high level of respect and recognition among the world's higher education institutions. For students, success in the IB often results in advanced standing, course credit, scholarships, and other admissions related benefits at many universities. Higher education institutions around the world admit students based on their IB credentials. Evidence does show that DP students tend to go on to tertiary study at higher rates than their peers, are admitted more often to selective institutions, and tend to perform better in their postsecondary studies, including higher rates of post-secondary completion.
